We are delighted to confirm the details of your University of Liverpool International Scholarship.

This award is made on the basis that you are classified as an overseas student and therefore eligible to pay tuition fees at the overseas rate.

• The University of Liverpool International Scholarship is valued at 25 per cent of the annual tuition fees for your chosen course (MSc Evolutionary Psychology).

You will receive the tuition fee reduction starting in September 2008 and for each year of study, subject to good academic progress (normally a minimum 60% average each year): -

• Tuition fees reduced from £11,650 to £8,738 per year.

You will be able to hold this award in addition to your International Advancement Award. This is £1,000 fee reduction, guaranteed regardless of grades and will be automatically be deducted from your tuition fees for each year of your studies*:-

• Tuition fees reduced from £8,738 to £7737.5 per year.

* The following applicants **<u>do not</u>** qualify for the International Advancement Award:

1. Undergraduate students joining clinical programmes within the Faculty of Medicine, the School of Dentistry or the Faculty of Veterinary Science;

2. Students studying part-time, or for diplomas;

3. Students studying for awards of the Liverpool School of Tropical Medicine;

4. Students registering for pre-University studies at Liverpool International College;.

5. Students whose study is already fully funded by a UK-Government Award, (eg Chevening, Dorothy Hodgkin and ORSAS), or those who are already fully funded from University sources eg Duncan Norman and Elizabeth Hodgkinson awards.

6. Students whose fees are being paid by an overseas funding body where a different agreement on fees is already in place. At the present time this includes:

a. Students funded by the Consejo Nacional de Ciencia Tecno logia (CONACYT);

b. Students funded by the Egyptian Government through the Egyptian Cultural Bureau in London;

c. Students funded by the Omani Ministry of Manpower within the International Placement Programme agreed with the UK-Oman PG Consortium.
